## The Japanese Society of Toxicologic Pathology Regulations on Membership Fees and Payment of Membership Fees

## (Objective)

Article 1. These Regulations stipulate the membership fee and matters related to the payment thereof pursuant to Articles 7 and 8 of the Articles of Incorporation of The Japanese Society of Toxicologic Pathology (hereinafter referred to as the "Society").

(Membership Fee)

Article 2. A member shall pay the membership fee; provided, however, that honorary members shall not be obliged to pay the same.

The amount of the annual membership fee shall be as follows:

General members:	10,000 yen
General members (Diplomates)	15,000 yen
General members (Councilors)	17,000 yen
General members (Councilors/Diplomates)	17,000 yen
Honorary members (Councilors/Diplomates)	Exempt
Meritorious members (Councilors/Diplomates)	10,000 yen
Student members:	5,000 yen
Supporting Member (1 unit)	50,000 yen

3 A new member shall pay the annual membership fee regardless of the timing of his/her admission.

(Method of Payment of Membership Fees)

Article 3. Membership fees shall be paid in the manner designated by the Society.

(Timing of Payment of Membership Fees)

Article 4. Membership fees for the following business year shall be paid by November 30 of each year.

(Loss of Membership in Cases of Delinquency in Payment of Annual Membership Fee)

Article 5. A member who fails to perform the obligation to pay the annual membership fee for two (2) years or more shall lose his/her qualification as a member of the Society, and the procedures therefor shall be separately stipulated in the guidelines for loss of membership due to a failure to pay the membership fee.

(Person whose Membership Fee is to be Changed)

Article 6. If one's membership fee changes within the fiscal year due to a change in membership type, such as acquiring certification as a diplomate of toxicologic pathology or assuming the office of Councilor, the membership fee shall not be changed in such fiscal year but shall be changed from the following fiscal year.

(Amendment and Abolition)

Article 7. These Regulations shall be amended or abolished by a resolution of the General Meeting.

Supplementary Provisions

- 1. These Regulations shall come into force on the date of establishment of the Society.
- 2. The above-mentioned general members, honorary members, meritorious members, student members, supporting members, Councilors, and diplomates of toxicologic pathology shall succeed the members of The Japanese Society of Toxicologic Pathology, which is the Society's predecessor organization.
